respected Breast Cancer Oncologists. Arlene is a founding member and Vice-Chair of Breast Cancer Research Centre-WA, which was established in 2009 as a not-for-profit breast cancer research and education organisation. She is passionate about improving outcomes for those diagnosed with breast cancer and has a strong commitment to breast cancer research.

Awarded a Western Australia of Year Award in 2016 for her contribution in the field of science at a state, national, and international level and was a finalist for Australian of the Year in 2017. She was inducted into the WA Women Hall of Fame in 2017. In 2018, she was awarded a Member of the Order of Australia in the Queen's Honors List for her contribution to the field of breast cancer oncology.
