Check if you're eligible to be featured in the Screening Saves Lives campaign:

Bowel screening

- ✓ Aged 45 to 74
- ✓ Have a bowel

Breast screening

- ✓ Aged 50 to 74
- ✓ Have breasts or chest tissue
- ✓ Have been taking gender affirming hormones for 5 years or more (trans women)

Cervical screening

- ✓ Aged 25 to 74
- √ Have a cervix
- ✓ Ever had any sexual contact

Lung screening

- ✓ Aged 50 to 70
- ✓ Currently smoke or quit within the past 10 years
- ✓ Have smoked the equivalent of a pack a day for 30 years
